


Figure 1. Front View




Figure 2. Back View




Figure 3. Base View (without battery)




Figure 4. Front View




Figure 5. Back View




Figure 6. Base View (without battery)




Figure 7. AC Adapter

2. Connect the network cable (optional).




Figure 8. Network Connector

3. Connect USB devices, such as a mouse or keyboard (optional).




Figure 9. USB Connector
